The January 20th meeting was held at the Main Street Café. There were approximately 11 members in attendance. The meeting was opened by Ross Bevevino at 8 A.M.

The minutes were read and unanimously approved after a motion and second respectively by Jay Dutton and Pastor J. Sevon.

TREASURER'S REPORT: There was no report. Previous balance is \$1548.98.

CAPRI: A general discussion was held regarding the future of CAPRI and the need for members. There are still opening for members on the board. If you have an interest contact Kim Shoup. The LSA presentation for the McGuffey Community Park Grant will be given on January 20, 2015, 3:00 P.M. at Room 104, Washington County Court House.

There are no defined projects going forward. Suggestions are always accepted. The meetings are always the 2nd Monday of the month at the Lodge.

BANNER PROJECT: This is an ongoing project. Kathy will contact Diane Adams to follow up and proceed from there.

DONEGAL TOWNSHIP: Mark West appeal hearing for the compressor station was held and resolution of the issue resulted in Mark West receiving a fine and requirement to obtain a permit prior to further construction. Application for a new permit has been made.

Chesapeake Energy has sold their interest in wells in the area to Southwestern Energy.

BOROUGH: Demolition of the property behind the nursing home has been completed. The borough did not take possession of the property, but it is liened at \$15,000.

To book the park pavilions for use please contact the borough office. Rates are \$100/\$80 depending on which pavilion is booked. New swing sets and playground equipment has been purchased and will be installed this spring.

A new building inspector has been contracted through North Strabane Township. As a result the Community Center renovation should be completed in a more timely manner with fewer complications.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Yancocek reported that activity was status quo.

JOINT MULTI-MUNICIPAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN COMMITTEE: An end of year report was completed and approved at the January 19 meeting. The report will be provided to the Washington County Redevelopment Authority, Claysville Borough and Donegal Township.

CBA: Elections were deferred to the February meeting. A continuing discussion was held regarding the benefit the CBA provides to businesses in the community. One of those benefits is an opportunity for businesses to participate in the Washington Chamber of Commerce without paying the \$250 fee. The CBA hold membership which allows all business association members to participate.
