The August 19th meeting was held at the Main Street Café. There were approximately 16 members in attendance. The meeting was opened by Ross Bevevino at 8 A.M.

The minutes were read and approved as submitted.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Current balance is \$2151.98. A motion for approval was made by Zachary Prescott and seconded by Kathy Prescott. Motion Approved.

CAPRI: The CAPRI representative reported that the MURAL was ongoing. Donations have been collected in the amount of \$10,765. The current account balance is approximately \$8,765.00. Diane Adams received an advance of \$2,000 for supplies. The goal has been reached, however, donations will still be accepted to be used for lighting the mural.

BANNER PROJECT: This is an ongoing project. Kathy will call Andrew Yetter and Diane Adams to follow up.

DONEGAL TOWNSHIP: The Joint Comprehensive Plan Commission will meet the 4th Monday of each month, alternating locations between the borough and township.

BOROUGH: The Christmas lights are worn out and there is need for new lights, The order is going out and will cost \$5,000, There are some issues with exposed wires and outlets.

The borough has contracted with North Strabane for code enforcement. HMT will no longer perform that task. The borough is in the process of razing condemned property on Petroleum behind Hixenbaugh Nursing Home. They have used all procedures required by the county and state, but it is a long process- they are currently getting bids to raze the building.

The park pavilions are booked through next year. The deposit and rent will go up next year. There is a possibility for a submission of an LSA grant for water and bathroom facilities.

Donna Riggle mentioned that she may have access to a bobcat, trencher and volunteers for water line work, when that work begins.

SCHOOL DISTRICT NEWS: Representatives were in training during this meeting.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Yancocek reported that things are status quo.
