

# Claysville Business Association

June 17, 2014

The July 17th meeting was held at the Main Street Café. There were approximately 13 members in attendance. The meeting was opened by Ross Bevevino at 8 A.M.

The minutes were read and approved as submitted.

No treasurer's report was available.

The CAPRI representative reported that the MURAL was ongoing. The current account balance is approximately \$7,614.00. Diane Adams received an advance of \$2,000 for supplies. There will continue to be a campaign to raise funds for the project. A discussion was held concerning having lighting on the mural. Nate Voytek and Mary Sollar have scheduled or will schedule a tour of the Sprowls Hardware building and make suggestions for its use.

**BANNER PROJECT:** This is an ongoing project. The letter is ready to send once we have a mock up and sample to include in the letter. Costs will be \$150 and \$75 each year after that to maintain and hang the banners.

**DONEGAL TOWNSHIP:** Aleta Richmond has been approved to be one of the representatives for the Comprehensive Plan/Joint Planning committee. The township continues growing through the gas industry. No current report on the hotel other than work is slowly continuing. They had a few more issues with the water authority and the rain water runoff. Lake Road is still an issue. Fish and Game is getting royalties from the 584 acres leased. State is addressing roads slips. However it is still an issue. The township has been having meetings with Mark West/Range Resources regarding "jake brakes", detour signs pointing wrong directions, speeding by trucks and trucks on the wrong roads. Township meetings are held the second Wednesday of each month. Residents are welcome to attend. Meetings begin at 7 PM.

**BOROUGH:** No report.

**SCHOOL DISTRICT NEWS:** Representatives were in training during this meeting.

**POLICE REPORT:** Chief Yancocek reported that things are status quo.

LSA GRANTS: Information was provided to members. Nate Voytek suggested a Façade Program for Main Street, which CAPRI will look in to. Another suggestion was for additional dusk to dawn lighting on Main Street. Grants must be submitted by October. There will be training sessions presented by the Wash. Redevelopment Auth. Dates to be announced. There was further general discussion on LSA grants, previous and possible options.

CLOCK: The borough clock has not been working correctly for some time. There is only one company which works on the clocks. Cost is projected to be about \$1000. A motion was made by Jay Dutton and seconded by Rico Vespa to repair the clock at the approximate cost of \$1000. Motion approved.
