June 17, 2014

The June 17th meeting was held at the Main Street Café. There were approximately 18 members in attendance. The meeting was opened by Ross Bevevino at 8 A.M.

The minutes were read and approved as submitted.

New attendees were Lisa Moore, First Federal of Greene County; Linda Duncan, Penn Gas Lands; Claudine Young, Young Funeral Home; Susanne Dorsey, Claysville Borough. Introductions were made of all members for the benefit of the new attendees.

The CAPRI representative reported that the MURAL was ongoing. The current account balance is approximately \$6,600. Diane Adams received an advance of \$2,000 for supplies. There will be an email blast to donors who previously donated to clock project and business association members. The last CAPRI meeting was held at Sprowls Hardware. The purpose was to tour the facility and brain storm ideas for its use and restoration. Donna Riggle mentioned that she had a possible contact for leasing some of the space. No concrete suggestions were made during the meeting.

BANNER PROJECT: This is an ongoing project. Andrew provided a draft letter to be sent out to businesses and used by visitors to businesses. He will provide a mock up and/or sample banner to include in the letter. Costs will be \$150 and \$75 each year after that to maintain and hang the banners.

DONEGAL/CLAYSVILLE JOINT PLANNING: The Comprehensive Plan/Joint Planning committee will be scheduling a meeting with Makin Engineering to go over the previous plan. One Donegal Township volunteer resigned. Aleta Richmond volunteered to be the representative, but will need to go to supervisors for approval.

BOROUGH: A question was asked about the sidewalks. Susanne stated that it was on a PENNDOT permit for PA American Water. They would be ones to contact. She reminded people that there limitations on the time covered. The CBA needs to go to the borough regarding the new banners. The borough doesn't have much to do with the banners except storing them, however, since they have to be hung the borough should be included in the discussion.

SCHOOL DISTRICT NEWS:

Next board meeting is scheduled for June 23. Construction work is ramping up for summer. Schools starts September 2nd. The talent contest/show was impressive.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Yancocek reported that things are status quo.

Regarding planters on Main Street. If we contact the school early next spring they may have organizations that will take on the planters as a project.
