The cost will be approximately \$50-55,000. They will be approaching other agencies for funding support. These are: CAPRI, Claysville Business Association, Wounded Warriors, TRIPIL and other organizations as well as grant programs. No rededication date has been set. The refill plan is on schedule and they want the event to take place when the lake is full.

**RELAY FOR LIFE** – The banners were up and are still up. Relay for life was very successful and fund raising for next year has begun. Dave Hildebrand should send the bill for the steel to Mark Marcishak at the bank.

**COMPREHENSIVE PLAN** - Jay has a copy of the plan. The borough and townships have a copy of the plan. Kim Shoup volunteered to give her copy of the plan to CAPRI/CBA.
